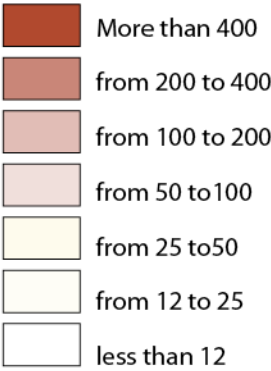
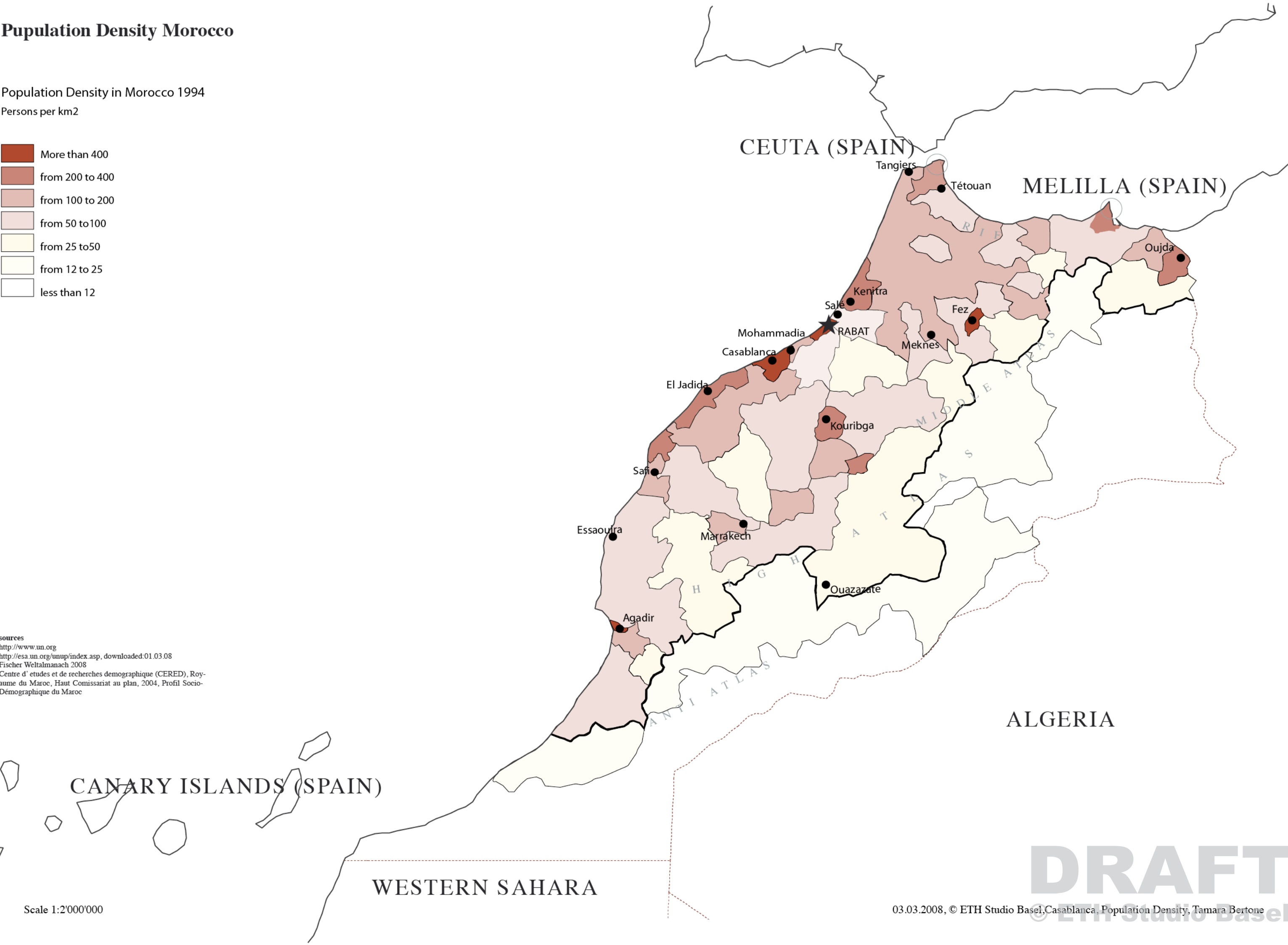


Population Density Morocco

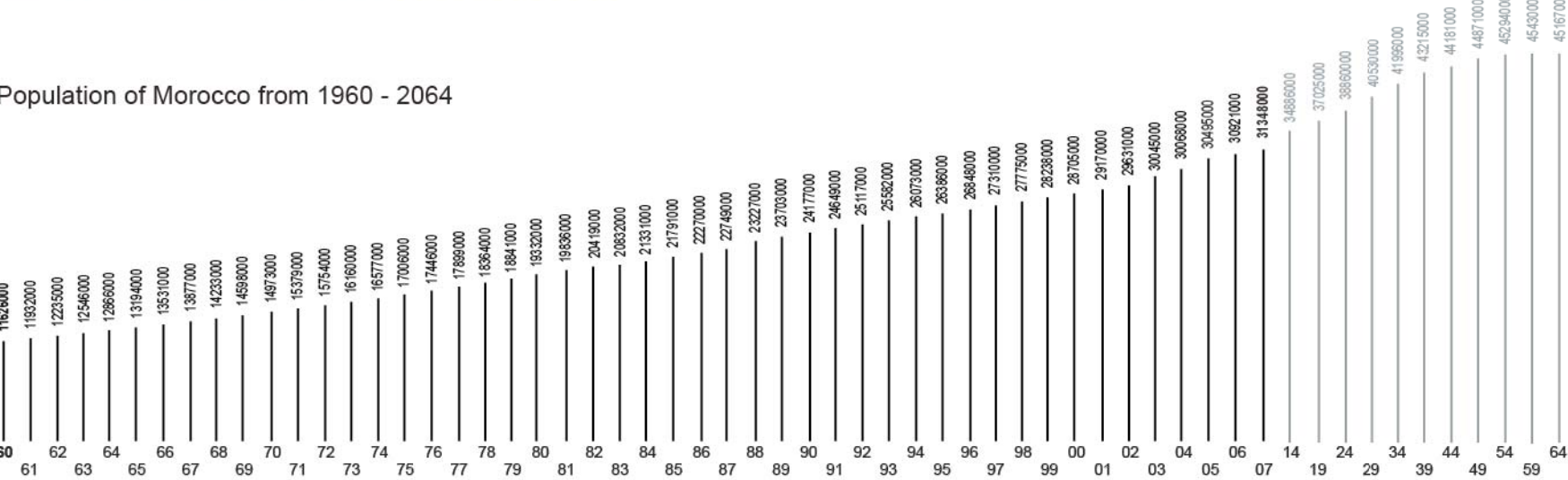

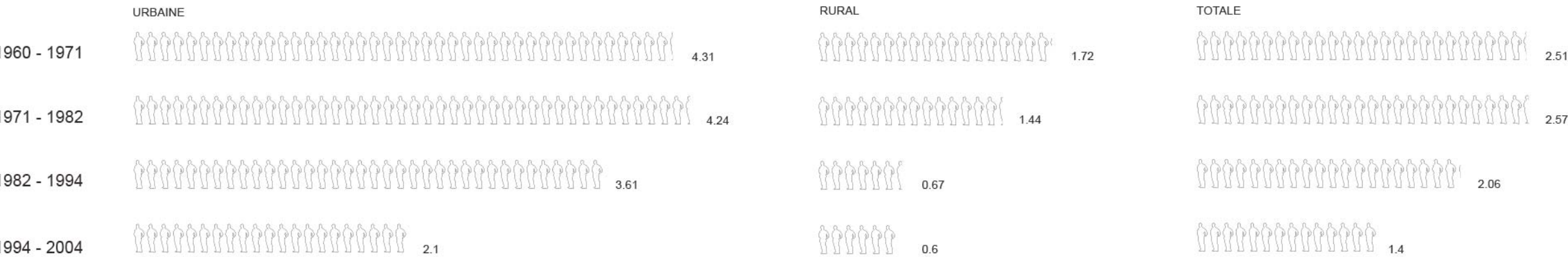
Urban and Rural Population Development of Morocco from 1950 - 2005



Population of Morocco from 1960 - 2064



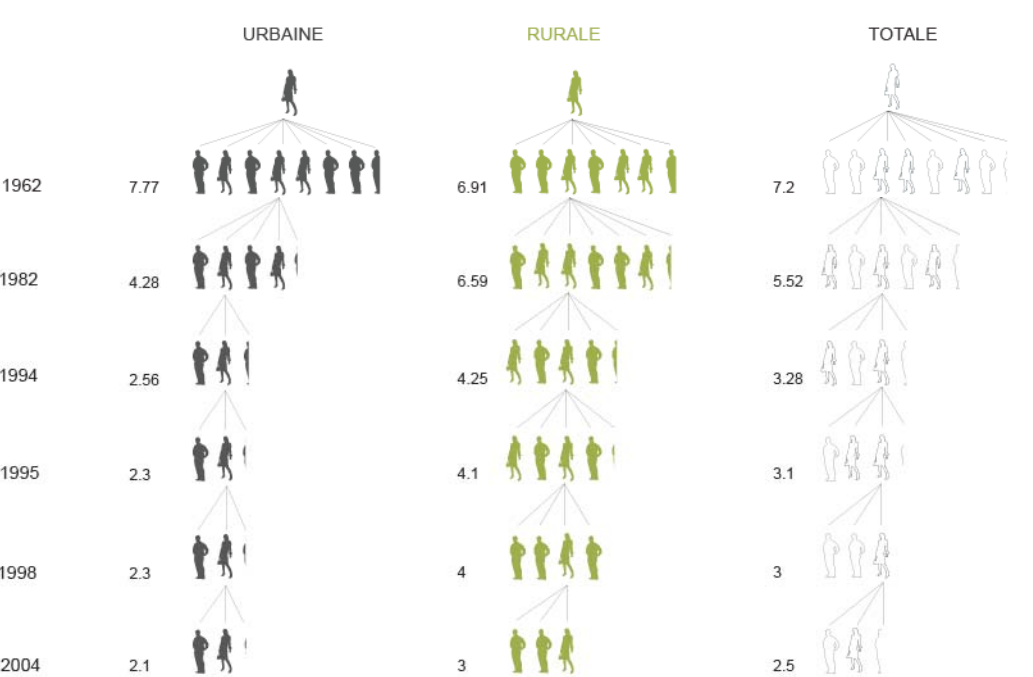
Population Growth Rate of Morocco from 1960 - 2004

Urban population
The urban population has highly grown in the last 40 yaers. From 1960 till 1980 the mi-gration from the rural aeras represent 40% of the growth. Today ther are about 300 000 migrants every year from rural into urban areas, about 22%

Maroccans in Europe
Since 1968 the part of maroccan emigrants in Europe has highly grown. In 2002 6.8% of the total maroccan population has lived in Europe.

Foreigner in Morocco
In the beginning of the 20 century the part of foreigners in Morocco was relatively high. 1918 47.7% of the total population of Maroc-co were foreigners.
